Delta Health Center Announces Two Medical Clinic at Rolling Fork, MS

March 26, 2023

Mound Bayou, MS: Delta Health Center announces the establishment of two medical clinics in Rolling Fork, MS. As part of our ongoing commitment to support Rolling Fork and the surrounding communities impacted by severe storms on March 24, 2023, Delta Health Center will open two medical clinics in the town of Rolling Fork. One in the parking lot immediately in front of the Delta Health Center clinic damaged by Friday’s storms (20400 Hwy 61), and a second, temporary location on the campus of Mount Lula Baptist Church (118 Maple Street). The purpose of the medical clinics are to provide urgent care to people in need, particularly those in need of insulin, blood pressure medications, tetanus shots and other medications in compliance with the state board of pharmacy. Delta Health Center will waive all co-pay fees, accepts most insurances, and treats patients regardless of their ability to pay. Patients should expect no out of pocket expenses.
